It's raining. Gabriel York is awaiting the arrival of his grown son whom he hasn't seen since he was seven. "I know what he wants. He wants what all young men want from their fathers. He wants to know who he is. Where he comes from. Where he belongs. And for the life of me I don't know what to tell him."

That's the beginning of a family saga that takes us back and forth in time from one generation to another, from 1959 to 2039, from London to Australia. With four generations of fathers and sons, their mothers, lovers and wives, this is both an epic and intimate play.

Australian playwright and screenwriter Andrew Bovell premiered *When the Rain Stops Falling* at Australia's 2008 Adelaide Festival, then took it to Sydney, Melbourne and London's Almeida – playing to sold-out houses and broad acclaim. The American premiere, at the Lincoln Center was named best new play of 2010 by Time Magazine, and won five Lucille Lortel Awards. Since then *When the Rain Stops Falling* has been produced regionally.
